- The completion of our cottage, the move to the mission land, the construction of a kitchen for our short term visitors, woodwork shop, and wonderful progress on our grain storage facility for the feeding program.
- The many who continue to make first time commitments to Christ as the mission and local church continue their witness to God's grace and goodness. Three men working for the mission on a temporary basis made commitments to Christ during our morning devotions.
- The awesome financial involvement of so many of you to building projects and ministry initiatives. Over \$45,000 was donated toward our mission house which will enable our cottage to be available for new missionaries expected.
- After some stressful weeks working on renewing Mozambique residency, renewal was achieved with none of the complications that could have occurred. We witnessed a few big miracles!
- The opening of 6 new extension Bible and leadership training schools, as well as the selection of 4 local pastors who will serve as supervisors for the four regions. Also for the unity and amazing ownership these key leaders have taken in regard to the program.
- Our children, Russell and Amanda's good progress in their studies and Russell's successful application to ATCO to serve his second work term with the Engineering co-op program.
- For the great progress Joao has made in University in Maputo. He was selected as class president only after a month of starting school. For an un-known orphan boy from Northern Mozambique to achieve this is significant.
- For the recovery of Eunice, one of our staff, who was bitten by a snake.
- For God's persistent work in lives of a number of young guys who fell away, but who God is restoring one by one.
